Featuring live lessons, continuous guidance, and preparation for official British qualifications, the programme ensures academic continuity without compromising on freedom of movement, personal projects, or an education tailored to each individual family.

WHAT IS NOMAD?

A STRUCTURED AND FLEXIBLE ONLINE PROGRAMME

Nomad is the core online programme of Montessori British, designed to offer a stable, supported, and adaptable educational experience for different lifestyles.

The programme combines live lessons, individual guidance, and academic planning within an international and flexible environment. Unlike other models focused solely on independent study.

Nomad maintains a daily structure and continuous guidance from the educational team. Students can continue their education from different parts of the world while maintaining:

- their lessons
- their teachers
- their peers
- their academic planning

This allows education to be balanced with travel, sports, personal projects, or international lifestyles without losing educational continuity..

WHO IS IT DESIGNED FOR?

Nomad is specially designed for families who need a more flexible education without compromising on structure, guidance, and academic continuity.

- The programme usually suits profiles such as:
- Families looking for a more flexible and personalised education
- Students who need a different organisation to that of the traditional system
- International families or those living outside
- Spain Families who travel frequently
- Athletes and artists who need to balance their education with training or personal projects
- Families with international lifestyles or digital nomads

Although the programme allows for a more flexible organisation, students maintain:

- live lessons
- continuous monitoring
- academic planning
- constant guidance from the educational team

ORGANISATION AND OPERATION

LIVE LESSONS AND CONTINUOUS GUIDANCE

Students participate daily in live online sessions with teachers and peers within a structured, supportive environment.

The programme combines live virtual lessons, individualised tracking, and academic planning to provide a stable and well-organised educational experience.

- Nomad includes:
- Live lessons
- Tutorials and progress monitoring
- Learning platform
- Coursework and assignment submission
- Continuous communication with the academic team

INTERNATIONAL AND FLEXIBLE TIMETABLE

Academic activity primarily takes place between 09:00 and 15:00 (Spanish Peninsular Time).

- The specific organisation may vary depending on:
- The educational stage
- The subjects
- The learner's profile
- The academic planning of each cohort

Where necessary, additional groups or alternative time slots may be introduced to accommodate our families' requirements.



FLEXIBLE AND PERSONALISED ORGANISATION

The academic structure adapts progressively based on:

- The educational stage
- The subjects
- Academic objectives
- The learner's individual needs

In specific cases, students may follow more intensive or tailored pathways within the British system. The aim is not to artificially increase the academic load, but to establish a coherent, efficient framework adapted to each situation.

An international education designed to adapt to new ways of living and learning.

A PROVEN TRACK RECORD

Nomad began developing as an online programme in 2020, initially providing a solution for families who required educational continuity within a more flexible and supportive environment.

Over time, the programme evolved into an international model capable of adapting to highly diverse profiles: travelling families, students living outside of Spain, athletes, artists, and learners with diverse educational needs.

Today, graduates educated at Montessori British have already progressed to national and international university studies in areas such as:

- Computer Engineering
- Psychology
- Criminology
- Audiovisual Communication
- Fine Art
- Sport and Exercise Sciences
- Civil Engineering

Our most recent cohorts continue to expand this academic journey, including cases of early entry into higher education through personalised pathways.

Flexibility only truly makes sense when accompanied by continuity and tangible results.



ACADEMIC STAGES

Nomad supports students throughout the various educational stages of the British system, combining flexibility, continuous guidance, and thorough preparation for official academic qualifications.

KEY STAGE 2 Primary Education

At KS2, Nomad offers an academic structure tailored to primary school students within a more flexible and personalised environment.

The primary objective is to consolidate academic foundations, foster independence, and maintain a stable, supported educational experience.

KEY STAGE 3 Lower Secondary Education

During KS3, students continue to progress through the Nomad programme within an increasingly broader and more autonomous framework.

At this stage, eligible students may also access **NEX**, a specialised programme specifically designed for adolescents who require an approach more closely aligned with their personal development and learning style.

KEY STAGE 4 & KEY STAGE 5 Official British Academic Preparation

At KS4 and KS5, Nomad incorporates advanced academic preparation geared towards official British qualifications, including:

- **IGCSE** (International General Certificate of Secondary Education)
- **International A Levels** (International Advanced Levels)
- **BTEC** (Business and Technology Education Council)

The academic organisation evolves progressively according to the stage, subjects, and individual goals of each student, whilst maintaining the flexibility and dedicated support that define the programme.

A flexible, structured academic journey adapted to each stage of development.

METHODOLOGY

INSPIRED BY MONTESSORI PEDAGOGY

The educational approach at Montessori British is founded on principles inspired by Montessori pedagogy, carefully adapted for an international, online environment.

Learning is understood as an active process through which the student progressively develops independence, responsibility, and organisational skills within a supportive and structured framework.

Nomad combines:

- Close, individualised support
- Small class sizes
- Active participation
- Adaptation to the learner's own pace

Alongside academic progress, the programme aims to foster essential life skills, including:

- Independence
- Organisation
- Communication
- Responsibility
- Adaptability

A more flexible, human-centred education, tailored to the unique reality of every student.



OFFICIAL QUALIFICATIONS

BRITISH SYSTEM WITH INTERNATIONAL RECOGNITION

Montessori British is an approved centre authorised by Pearson Edexcel, one of the most internationally recognised British educational organisations.

Through the Nomad programme, students can prepare for various official qualifications within the British system, tailored to their educational stage and academic goals:

- iGCSE
- A Levels
- BTEC

These qualifications are widely recognised globally and provide access to higher education in numerous countries.

In certain cases, they can also be validated within the Spanish educational system in accordance with current regulations.

CONTINUOUS MONITORING AND ACADEMIC SUPPORT

Assessment is not based solely on exams or one-off tests. Student progress is evaluated continuously through:

- Active participation
- Daily coursework
- Projects
- Academic progression
- Individualised tracking carried out by the educational team

Montessori British also acts as an official Pearson Edexcel exam centre in Murcia, facilitating access to these qualifications within a supportive and flexible academic environment.

Nevertheless, the legal framework surrounding schooling can depend on external factors and the unique circumstances of each family.

For this reason, we recommend assessing each case on an individual basis.

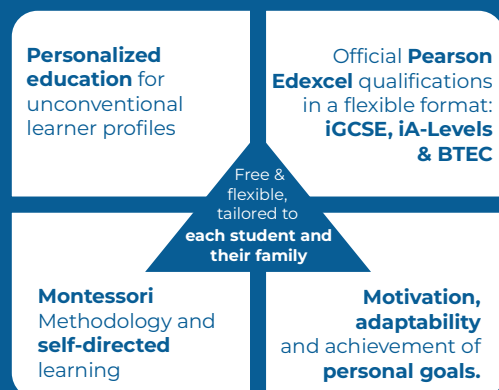
The school's main objectives include offering an alternative, free and flexible system that adapts to the needs of students and their families.

We bring an innovative and personalized programs for students who approach education in an unconventional way. Our typical students are digital nomads, world-traveling families, athletes, artists, gifted students, homeschoolers, and worldschoolers.

We offer the world-renowned Pearson Edexcel qualifications (iGCSE, iA-Levels and BTECS) which can be prepared independently, as private candidates at our official exam centre (in Murcia, Spain), online or in a hybrid mode from one of our Montessori Residences (Erdkinder), and a Montessori Primary programme based on the UK National Curriculum.

Our methodology includes tools from Montessori Pedagogy, the Agile model, self-directed learning, self-education, creativity and a global mindset. We want our students to achieve everything they set out to do: go to university, start their own successful businesses, pursue a professional or artistic career or work for the best companies in the world.

We can help restore confidence and motivation for studies. Geographical relocation, chronological freedom, adaptation to cognitive styles. We know that each student is different and we will adapt as much as possible the elements necessary to obtain a qualification that allows you to achieve everything you set out to do.





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PEARSON EDEXCEL

As a Pearson Edexcel authorized center, we have several levels of studies, which although we consider independent of age, have the equivalence with the Spanish system:

- iGCSE - we prepare subjects for secondary school approval, focusing on the most important content to ensure maximum results in the shortest possible time. Spanish, English, Mathematics, Geography and Science.
- iAlevels - we prepare you to obtain the equivalence to the Baccalaureate and access university courses all over the world. To access Spanish universities, it is necessary to obtain accreditation through Unedassis and, depending on the studies, perhaps take a general entrance exam from the British system (a simplified selectivity) or a specific one from the university of choice.
- iBTEC - we teach Business and Technology Education Council courses across a range of subjects and levels.

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Programa Nomad+ (Online)

Our Nomad+ program allows you to travel and move around the world while maintaining your school relationships and personalized curriculum, without having to change schools, classmates, teachers, etc.

Putting the student at the center, we believe that the curriculum should be personalized and independent of age, sex, location, etc.

We offer online lessons in the morning and afternoon, depending on the program, between 1 and 5 lessons per day (in blocks of about 50 minutes). Our teachers are trained to achieve meaningful learning in students.

Students are involved in interesting and purposeful projects, they can progress independently but do not have homework or exams as a central part of the assessment.

The language of instruction is English in most programs, but we can also integrate Spanish and a multilingual platform.

Classes are held online, daily, and allow students to have the same group of classmates, teachers, progress monitoring, curriculum, etc. wherever they are: traveling, in a residence far from the school, in our Erdkinder...

Erdkinder (Montessori Residence)

Erdkinder is a German term that refers to an education based on nature and real life, which focuses on the real needs of adolescents. It means "Children of the Earth" and Montessori chose it for the Secondary School program because of the idea of working productively, with the hands, with effective and real work.

Our Erdkinder is a secondary education programme that focuses on practical education and nature, and takes place in an outdoor environment, at our physical centres in the United Kingdom or Spain.

Among the reasons why we know that the Erdkinder program is the perfect complement to the academic and professional training we offer, are:

- **Development of practical skills:** Practical skills are acquired that are important in real life, such as farming, cooking, carpentry, gardening, mechanics, electricity, etc. These skills can help one become more independent and self-sufficient.
- **Fostering Responsibility:** Everything is geared towards being responsible for one's own learning and well-being. The program provides the opportunity to make decisions and assume responsibilities that are essential for one's own growth and development.
- **Social development:** Students work in teams and learn to collaborate with others to carry out projects. They also learn to respect and care for the environment and natural resources, which helps them develop a social and environmental awareness, and to find their purpose in life and to orient themselves at all levels: professional and personal.



Erdkinder (Montessori Residence)

- Practical and meaningful learning: The foundation is learning by doing and experiencing. The program focuses on practical experience and meaningful learning, which means that adolescents learn in a way that makes sense to them and that they can apply to their everyday lives.
- Emotional development: Responsible freedom implies greater self-confidence. Our students also learn to manage stress and anxiety, and develop a greater ability to cope with life's challenges and problems.



Hybrid model

Montessori British's hybrid classroom model combines the best of in-person and online education to provide students with a comprehensive and flexible educational experience. This approach is tailored to students' individual needs and preferences, allowing them to get the most out of their learning.

In the hybrid class model, students have the option to attend in-person classes at the Montessori British educational center or participate in online classes from the comfort of their home. This flexibility allows students to adapt their schedule and learning environment to their personal needs.

During in-person classes, students have the opportunity to interact directly with their peers and participate in hands-on activities.

Furthermore, the Montessori British hybrid classroom model focuses on the comprehensive development of students, not only in the academic aspect, but also in the development of practical, emotional and social skills. Project-based learning, problem solving and creativity are promoted.
